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## Survey of Roads in Town Park July 2<sup>d</sup>

The Supervisors of the Town of Polk & Richfield met at the house of Nicolas Wagner in the Town of Richfield on the 2<sup>d</sup> day of July A.D. 1851. for the purpose of deciding upon the application of John Butterfap and others of the Town of Polk and Nicolas Wagner of the Town of Richfield, for a Road or alteration of a Road on the line of the Town aforesaid.

The following were the proceedings had upon the application aforesaid. Mathias Schupp was duly sworn and interrogated as to the legality of serving notice upon owners or occupants of lands through which the road was petitioned to be established upon satisfactory evidence that the proceedings thus far were legal.

The Supervisors of Each of the aforesaid Towns established a Road or alteration of the Town line Road as follows to wit:

(24) Beginning at the post on the Town line sixteen chains and fifty links (16.5) East of the NW corner of Section four (4) in the Town of Richfield. Thence running South three degrees and thirty minutes East (S.3°30') five chains and twenty eight links (5.28) Thence South forty six degrees East (S.46°E) four chains and thirty nine links (4.39) to the Eastline of the NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section four owned or occupied by Philip Rosa. Thence running North fifty two degrees East (N.52°E) one chain and fifty four links (1.54) Thence North thirty six degrees East (N.36°E) Three Chains & forty eight links (3.48) Thence North forty eight degrees East (N.48°E) six chains and four links to the Town line aforesaid on the N. line of the NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section four on Land owned or occupied by John I Loffy. The Supervision of Each Town mutually ordered that part of the Road formerly established upon the Town line, between the points of beginning and termination of said alteration as herewith described to be discontinued and so much of the

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Same as before as to the NW<sup>1/4</sup> of Section 4, to revert to the owners thereof, and first offered to pay to Philip Rosa owner or occupant of the NW<sup>1/4</sup> of NW<sup>1/4</sup> of Section 4, the sum of Eighteen Dollars for his damages in consequence of Said alteration. And John J. Stoff, the sum of twelve Dollars for his damages upon the NW<sup>1/4</sup> & SW<sup>1/4</sup> of said Section four in consequence of Said alteration. The said parties refused the 24 proposition, and offers made thereon and would not stipulate any amount for their damages. The Supervisors thereupon established the Road according to the foregoing, filed & voted it to be opened as the Law requires.

The further divided the Town line into Road Districts as follows. To wit Ordered that so much of said line as lays between Section one in Richfield No. 67 and Section 36 in Polk shall belong to the Town of Polk to be kept in Repair and also each alternate Section along Said Line, that is to say the Lines between Sections 38 & 34, & 58, 32, and the Town of Richfield to build and keep in Repair the remaining part of Said Road which runs or is near Said Line.  
 Note: No. 67 does not lay out any road, but does show that the towns recognized the existence of a road laying along the section line.

The Supervisors adjourned same day.
